Practice rounds may be booked with the Office at times convenient to the club for £25. Buggies £28.

On the Day please allow for traffic congestion on motorways and on narrow approach roads to the club.

Registration from 8.15 am at the desk in the upstairs lounge. Coffee and bacon rolls included.

Practice Ranges: Upper Practice Field: Tokens at £3 each for a basket of 50 balls available from the Pro Shop – Lower Practice Field: use your own balls for free

Clubhouse: NO TOWELS PROVIDED unless in emergency. Security cannot be guaranteed. THERE IS NO LOCAL MOBILE PHONE SIGNAL - the Club phone is available in emergency.

Competition The Final is between seven teams of ten players each: Wrotham Heath (Group A), Gillingham (Group B), **TBA** (Group C), Sene Valley (Group D), Shooters Hill (Group E), Weald of Kent (Group F) and **TBA** (Group G).

Tee times: Shotgun start at 9.30 am from tees 1-8 and 12-18. All players should reach their designated tee at least 5 minutes before their tee time. Allow 15 mins to reach more distant tees

Format: YELLOW tees. Better ball Stableford – Each player's Handicap Index will be adjusted to the Course Handicap and rounded down to 85% Playing Handicap. Maximum HCI 22 = Max Course Hcap 25 = Max Playing Handicap 22. All scores aggregated to determine the champion club. Any ties will be determined by the best team aggregate for holes 10-18, 13-18 etc.

Dress Code on the Course: Please observe club's published dress rules for players on the course – especially that **SHIRTS MUST BE TUCKED IN**

Local Rules: **COURSE WIDE SMOKING BAN in effect until further notice**. Please repair divots and pitch marks, and rake bunkers.

TO SPEED UP PLAY PLEASE PICK UP WHEN YOU CANNOT SCORE.

CARDS MUST RECORD WHICH PLAYER ACHIEVES THE BETTER BALL SCORE (FOR BOTH THE PLAYERS' PAIR AND MARKER'S PAIR). ERRORS MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

Buggies: Buggies may only be used by players who provide a medical certificate and then only if weather permits and by giving prior notice and booking. Any such player wishing to bring his own buggy must demonstrate full insurance.

After Play: Please check and sign cards carefully and return them promptly to the registration desk.

Meal: Dress – smart casual. Rolling buffet from 2.00 p.m. The MENU is - MAIN roast loin of pork served with boulangere potatoes, Kentish apple sauce & stuffing, with fresh seasonal vegetables - DESSERT fresh lemon sponge with custard - Coffee to finish. Please advise any special dietary requirements well in advance. All drinks to be paid for at the bar.

Presentations: All players are requested to remain for the presentation of the Rochester & Cobham Cup and individual medals. This will take place as soon as possible after 3.00 p.m.
