Practice rounds may be arranged with the Professional in the week before the final at times convenient to the host club for £15. Buggies cost £25.

On the Day, Substantial time should be allowed for the journey as traffic can be congested in the early morning. Leave bags and trolleys on the patio on the LEFT HAND SIDE of the building (near the putting green) and enter through the patio doors adjacent door to the Pro Shop. NB Not the main entrance.

Registration from 8.30 am at the desk in the first floor restaurant area – COLLECT YOUR score card – free coffee/tea or collect vouchers for bacon rolls from bar at £3.50.

Practice range: £3 for a basket of 30 balls;

Gents Changing Room and Showers located opposite Pro Shop on ground floor – obtain entry code for the day from Pro Shop. NB Security cannot be guaranteed.

Competition The Final is between six teams of ten players each: Woodlands Manor (Group A), Bearsted (Group B), [Canterbury or Chestfield] (Group C), Tenterden (Group D), Langley Park (Group E) and [Weald of Kent or Boughton] (Group F) - Tee-times from 10.00am to 11.04am (6 groups from 10th tee, 9 from 1st tee) better ball Stableford, 9/10ths handicap (max 21, net 19), yellow tees, all scores aggregated to determine the champion club. Any ties will be determined by the best team aggregate for holes 10-18, 13-18 etc. To speed up play PLEASE PICK UP WHEN YOU CANNOT SCORE. Cards must record which person achieves the better ball of both the players' pair (A or B) and the marker's pair (C or D) – PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL MARKERS ARE EDUCATED TO COMPLETE A CARD PROPERLY AS ERRORS CAN RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

Prizes for NEAREST THE PIN in two shots on holes 7 and 15. NB The halfway house will be open for purchase of snacks and soft drinks.

SOFT SPIKES ONLY. Hedgehog wheels may be mandatory if conditions are very wet. Anyone using a **Buggy** (cost £25) **in the competition** IF WEATHER PERMITS must declare a medical necessity and any such player wishing to bring his own buggy must demonstrate full insurance.

After Play: Please check and SIGN cards and (for security) stow bags etc in your cars BEFORE CHANGING. We will try to collect cards as you leave the course to speed up the audit process; or please deliver cards at desk on FIRST FLOOR. All drinks after play will be at individual discretion.

Meal: Dress SMART CASUAL. Please sit in the fours in which you played. ROLLING BUFFET CARVERY from 3.00pm – CHOICE of meats followed by a CHOICE of sweets (any dietary changes to be advised well in advance).

Presentations ASAP after 4.00pm (all players requested to remain please) - Rochester & Cobham Cup to winners and medals to each player
